

## ***The Neonatal Transfer Service***

The ambulance that comes to collect your baby will be specially designed and equipped with the necessary specialist equipment to provide intensive care for sick newborn babies.

Your baby will be placed in an incubator to keep it warm, will have its heart rate, breathing and blood pressure monitored and may require equipment to help with breathing.

This will ensure a safe transfer to the unit that will care for your baby.

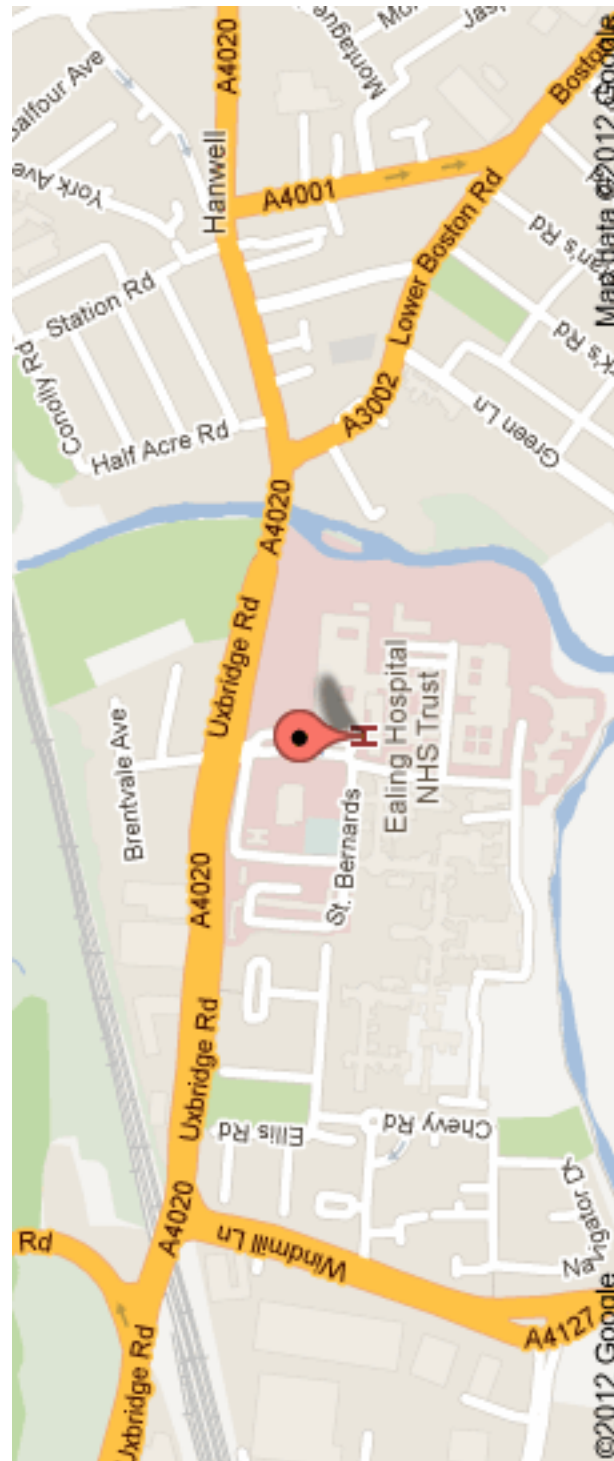
The transport team will all be specialists in the care of sick, newborn babies and will include a doctor or an advanced neonatal nurse practitioner, a senior neonatal nurse and a Paramedic. They will all have undertaken specialist transport training.

## Information on about the Neonatal Unit and local Amenities

### By public transport:

**Route 1:** By Underground - Central or District line or main line from Paddington to Ealing Broadway then the 607 (express), 207 or 83 bus direct to Ealing Hospital.

**Route 2:** By Underground - Central Line to Greenford, then 92 bus to Ealing Hospital.

**Route 3:** By Underground - Piccadilly line to Boston Manor, then E8 bus to the top of Lower Boston Road.

### By car:

#### **Travel from central London**

A40 Westward until sign to Greenford (A4127). Turn left down Greenford Road to Uxbridge Road (see map).

#### **Access from the M25 Travelling from the north**

Exit 16 to M40/A40 Western Avenue - drive towards London. Take the Greenford exit (A4127).

Turn right at roundabout and travel down Greenford Road, then turn left onto Uxbridge Road (see map).

#### **Access from the M25 Travelling from the south**

Exit 15 to M4 - drive towards London.

At exit 3 take the A312 Hayes by-pass travelling north, follow signs to Southall/Ealing A4020 Uxbridge Road. Continue on this road through Southall to the hospital (see map).

### Parking details

Parking spaces are limited. A visitor pay and display car park is provided at the front of the hospital with a few extra spaces outside the entrance to the maternity unit. There is minimum charge of £1.50 for four hours parking. Free parking spaces for registered disabled drivers are situated by the main entrance.
