### The Neonatal Transfer Service

The ambulance that comes to collect your baby will be specially designed and equipped with the necessary specialist equipment to provide intensive care for sick newborn babies.

Your baby will be placed in an incubator to keep it warm, will have its heart rate, breathing and blood pressure monitored and may require equipment to help with breathing.

This will ensure a safe transfer to the unit that will care for your baby.

The transport team will all be specialists in the care of sick, newborn babies and will include a doctor or an advanced neonatal nurse practitioner, a senior neonatal nurse and a Paramedic. They will all have undertaken specialist transport training.

# Information on about the Neonatal Unit and local Amenities

#### **Parking**

There are 254 public spaces available in the hospital car park and a residents' parking scheme operates in streets around the site. Drivers can reach the hospital's 24-hour, payon-exit car park from the main entrance in Lyndhurst Road. There are also drop-off and pick-up points, in which free waiting is limited to 20 minutes, as well as disabled parking bays. A council-run pay-and-display car park is also available in Beach House Park, on the opposite side of Lyndhurst Road to the hospital.

#### By rail

Worthing station is a 10-minute walk from the hospital, which is well-signposted from the station area. Trains run to: Brighton and East-bourne in the east, Littlehampton, Chichester, Portsmouth and Southampton in the west, Haywards Heath, Gatwick Airport and London Victoria to the north.

#### By London underground

Most train services to and from Worthing are provided by Southern and South West Trains.
